WTO issues new edition of World Tariff Profiles

The World Trade Organisation (WTO) has recently published the 2022 edition of “World Tariff Profiles”, which compiles information on the tariffs and non-tariff measures imposed by over 170 countries and customs territories. The report was jointly prepared with the International Trade Centre and the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD). Summary tables at the start of the publication provide cross-country comparisons of the average "bound" or maximum tariff each economy may apply to imports from other WTO members and the average tariffs it applies in practice: https://www.wto.org/english/news_e/news22_e/publ_29jul22_e.htm
